1. If a disaster or emergency situation can be predicted in advance, the school will notify students by the end of the previous school day.
 2. Information will also be posted on Google Classroom. Please refrain from contacting the school by telephone for inquiries.

Weather Warnings and Special Emergency Warnings

Applicable Warnings

- **Storm Warning**
- Emergency Warning
- Special Emergency Warning

Area Covered

Any area within **Osaka Prefecture**

Class Schedule

- If the warning is lifted by **3:00 PM** → Classes will be held as usual.
- If the warning is lifted by **4:00 PM** → Classes will begin at **6:30 PM**.

However, please come to school only if it is safe to do so.

School Closure

If a warning is still in effect at **4:00 PM**, the school will be closed.

In the Event of an Earthquake

How Information Will Be Provided

Information will be posted on **Google Classroom**.

School Response

If an earthquake of **Lower 5 (Shindo 5-) or greater** occurs anywhere in Osaka Prefecture:

While at School

- Classes will generally be suspended.
- Students will remain at school until safety can be confirmed.
- Students will be dismissed gradually after checking transportation conditions and safety.

While Commuting to or from School

- Ensure your personal safety first.
- Evacuate and wait either at school, at home, or at whichever location is closer and safer.

Family Preparedness

Each family should confirm in advance:

- Emergency evacuation locations
- Family meeting points during emergencies

Note: The same procedures apply when a **J-Alert** is issued in Osaka Prefecture.

Suspension of Public Transportation Services

Applicable Transportation

Any transportation service that a student normally uses to commute to school.

Student Responsibilities

If your transportation service is suspended:

- Contact your homeroom teacher or grade-level teacher as soon as possible.
- The absence or lateness will **not** be counted against you.
- During examination periods, special consideration will be given so that you are not placed at a disadvantage.
